Our congratulations for a job well done! You are all amazing!






Surrendering the Secret

A passion on our hearts at GTARTL has been for the post abortive community. Many, struggle for years with repressed memories, guilt, shame, and depression. Most women feel they are not allowed to talk about their abortion experience, especially in

church. The truth is many women who have had an abortion suffer from symptoms of post-abortion grief and trauma. Most often, neither the medical community nor the church understands abortion as a risk factor in a woman's physical, spiritual or emotional health. If you feel you have never completely healed or recovered from an abortion experience, or that a past abortion may be affecting your current quality of life, then Surrendering the Secret (STS) by Pat Layton is for you.

I helped co-lead a Surrendering the Secret (STS) Bible Study last September at New Hope Church, we had 3 women sign-up and 1 that finished. We tried to start another STS group in TC in October 2019, but had no sign-ups for the class. I have to admit, at first I was discouraged...but I know that Satan would love for me to get discouraged and drop this whole thing. But that is NOT an OPTION. So, January 14th, we had an STS group of 2 women that met at Bayview Church in TC and they both completed the 8-week course!! I felt very privileged to get to know and walk alongside these brave women as we embarked on this healing journey together. They expressed to me how important they thought this Bible Study was and that we need to have this in our community. They were so thankful for all the supplies that were provided to them for free. GTARTL was able to do that because of our generous donors like you! The cost for one woman is \$25. On Mother's Day I reached out to these ladies and wished them a Happy Mother's Day. The one expressed this Mother's Day was more special for her because of the healing in her heart because of our class together. This is a life changing Bible Study! STS is a study designed to bring women together who understand the need for seeking peace with the past and desire a better understanding of God's plan for making the most painful losses of our past work for His glory!

We have an STS packet for Pastors that explains the Bible Study and has informational brochures that can be put in the lobbies and counseling rooms of your church. This year has been tumultuous for so many, including your Grand Traverse Right to Life Office. Many of you are wondering how has this affected our office and our endeavor to protect LIFE. I would like to take a few moments to share with you what has been going on here. Our staff is blessed to be able to work from home remotely, and I have been able to social distance myself from everyone as I am the only one at the office and the doors are locked from the public. So thankful to our Lord as we know many have not been able to work.

This time has been difficult to say the least. We have rescheduled our May 21st Golf Benefit to July 30th. (please be praying for this event as it is what helps us keep our doors open!). Our yearly Mother's and Father's Day Fundraisers and the NW MI Fair have been cancelled. We are praying for our September 28th Focus on Life Dinner. This is an educational outreach and we have Mike Huckabee scheduled to speak. We are planning on a live event as well as an online event. So please stay tuned for updates on this.

Everywhere around us, there has been a heaviness... that is so hard to describe. I say that to say this... I think the heaviness that we are feeling is just the reality of being in uncharted waters....You see God calls us into deep waters....He does not want us to stand in the safety of the shore. But He wants us to trust Him and know that He is with us in these deep waters we are all experiencing. Please remember that our boat is sturdy and our crew is apt and God commands the winds and the waves.... In my own life and businesses, I have had, I have weathered some pretty bad storms...I am always reminded of a quote by Louisa May Alcott that reads: "I am not afraid of storms, for I am learning how to sail my ship" May this storm teach us all how to better sail this ship that God has entrusted us with...that He would use this storm to help us work together better. To help us unite. When sailing and the winds are forceful and you have to reef in the sail it can be difficult to do....but when you reef it in correctly you can maintain control of the boat in heavy weather and it can be a boat saving and lifesaving procedure. May we all take a moment and remember that God is in control and He has assembled this team for such a time as this and I am so thankful for the rough waters as we learn to better sail our ship.

Mark 4:35-41 New Living Translation (NLT) Jesus Calms the Storm ³⁵ As evening came, Jesus said to his disciples, "Let's cross to the other side of the lake." ³⁶ So they took Jesus in the boat and started out, leaving the crowds behind (although other boats followed). ³⁷ But soon a fierce storm came up. High waves were breaking into the boat, and it began to fill with water. ³⁸ Jesus was sleeping at the back of the boat with his head on a cushion. The disciples woke him up, shouting, "Teacher, don't you care that we're going to drown?" When Jesus woke up, he rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Silence! Be still!" Suddenly the wind stopped, and there was a great calm. ⁴⁰ Then he asked them, "Why are you afraid? Do you still have no faith?" ⁴¹ The disciples were absolutely terrified. "Who is this man?" they asked each other. "Even the wind and waves obey him!"

**PROGRESS ON
DISMEMBERMENT BAN**

After a long pause, the Bureau of Elections (BOE) has pulled a sample of 500 of our petitions and is validating - comparing names to the state's qualified voter list etc. They will determine whether we have enough valid signatures and send their recommendation to the Board of Canvassers who will vote and if they approve, will send to the Legislature for a vote. A majority vote in both the House and Senate will pass the ban into law and the Governor cannot veto it. Right to Life of Michigan and our attorney will be closely watching and participating in this whole process. The BOE has set June 1st as the deadline for any challenges to our signatures. A challenge from Planned Parenthood is expected. Please pray for the success of this effort, and stay up-to-date on our Facebook page.
